Klassik's dam is Country Charm who also carried several riders to many honors in and out of the show world. Charm's dam is Amyr Rose Marie, a kind sweet natured mare that I enjoyed showing in many different classes with trail being a favorite. Kayce's sire is the black stallion Shah of Gizeh from Dr. Jane Fassinger Lee's farm which has produced many talented horses.

As a frisky foal, Kayce enjoyed romping in the large pasture with her many relatives. Saddle training progressed with few problems. Kayce is friendly with a calm trainable attitude. Kayce prefers the slow easy pace of the western division. The hunter division was a bit of a challenge to convince her that a "working" trot was really necessary. I feel that it is an honor to raise, train and show such a lovely mare.

Kayce is my sixth horse to earn the honor of Horse of the Year.

Also, with Kayce's assistance, I received the honor of 2010 Rider of the Year. In 1976, when the circuit was formed by a group of friends sitting around Dr. Richard Stoneback's kitchen table, little did I realize what a great journey I was to be part of.

My first horse was a lanky palomino yearling filly named Tapioca that became my best friend. Her first foal I named Country's High Commander. Thus, was the beginning of Country Arabians. Every new foal crop brings a promise of future dreams and new experiences as the training process must adjust to the personality of every individual.

My journey with the Circuit has included many of these talented foals that have matured into wonderful partners. I have enjoyed my time with them. Watching other people bond with them truly warms my heart!

My sincere thanks to my family, my friends and to all the volunteers that make the Circuit so enjoyable.
